Margarita V Revzin, MD, MS currently serves as an Assistant Professor of Radiology and Biomedical Imaging at the Yale University School of Medicine. In addition to her expertise in vascular, abdominal, and gynecologic imaging, she brings vast experience in the field of radiologic education.

After receiving her Bachelor of Arts and Master's Degrees in Biology from New York University, Dr. Revzin received her MD degree from the Pennsylvania State University College of Medicine. She completed her residency in Diagnostic Radiology at Northwell University/Health System, NY, and a fellowship in Abdominal and Interventional Imaging at Brigham and Women's Hospital, MA. Dr. Revzin is a fellow of the Society of Radiologists in Ultrasound (SRU), and a Senior member of the AIUM. Dr. Revzin began her academic radiology career in 2009 as a clinical instructor at the BWH, MA. In 2010 she joined the Yale University, where she currently maintains her appointment.

Dr. Revzin has received multiple education awards including the **RSNA Honored Educator Award**. She published multiple peer reviewed articles, book chapters, and has presented a number of scientific and educational abstracts at national meetings.
